The information on the FAFSA is used to determine what type of financial aid you may be eligible for. The College's deadline for completing the FAFSA is May 10, 2012. Completing your FAFSA by this date will allow each applicant to be considered for the most financial aid possible. Jarvis Christian College's School Code is (003637). Remember financial aid is first-come, first-serve and a lot of funds are limited.

Submit proof of health insurance, Physical Form and Meningitis Form by May 10, 2012 (the Physical Form and Meningitis Form must be completed and signed by a physician)

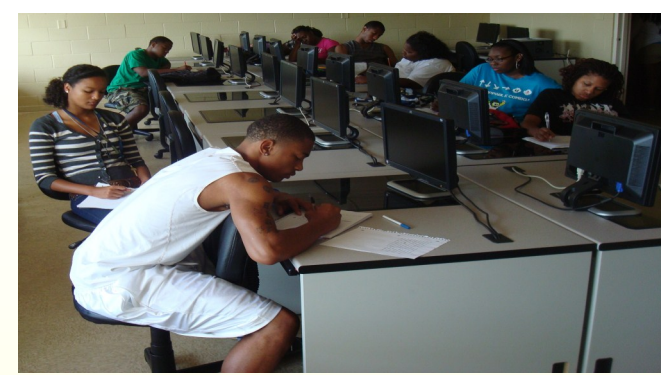
